I wanted to take a moment to thank you for the use of the ATV Park the weekend of June 26 and 27. Emergency services from Noga EMS, Robinson EMS, Mon-Valley EMS, Murrys ville EMS, Groveton and Forest Grove Fire Departments and Collier Twp Police brought their UTV's and ATV's to the park for live training. The sole purpose of the exercise was to become familiar with the operation of specialty UTV's under real conditions, and Mines and Meadows gave us that opportunity.

Once the familiarization was completed, we began training evolutions with search and rescue teams from Air, Search, and Rescue from Pittsburgh. We had 8 search dogs and handlers from their organization that participated as well and had live training finding lost victims.

The fire departments and search and rescue teams brought state of the art GPS tracking devices with them and deployed them as well during the day. We finished off the night with a search and rescue at night, recovering a "rescue dummy" around 1am.

The training opportunities afforded to these personnel by your business will at some point, save someone's life. And for that, we are eternally grateful for your generosity.
